Directions: From I-95 south of Fredericksburg: I-95 to Exit 126A onto US-1 North to Fredericksburg. 0.9 Miles Turn right onto Mine Rd. 1.5 miles turn left onto Lansdowne Rd. 2.4 miles at the end of the road turn right onto tidewater Trail. 0.5 miles Turn right onto Shannon Airport Circle. From I-95 north of Frederickburg: I-95 south to Exit 130A onto VA-3 East toward Fredericksburg. 2.9 miles take exit toward Tappahannock, Bowling Green. 1.5 miles turn right onto Shannon Airport Circle.
