The facility is on the SOUTH side of the Portland International Jetport. Aviation Blvd is near the intersection at the end of Jetport Plaza Road and the end of Westbrook Street. Both roads are off Western Ave.

If approaching on Jetport Plaza Road, continue to the end, turn right and take the first left onto Aviation Blvd. If approaching on Westbrook Street, Aviation Blvd is on the right just before the road ends at the airport perimeter. Turn onto Aviation Blvd, in less than 1/4 mile turn left into MAC Air and park just beyond MAC Air, enter the classroom adjacent to the parking lot.
