Navigating the Legal Process of an Aviation Accident

This session will enhance attendees' awareness of the nuances of the legal process in the event of an accident, including:

- The amount of preparedness advisable in advance of an accident event
- How to respond when an accident occurs,
- Working with authorities and the array of evidence to be sought and preserved
- Traps and pitfalls for the unwary
- The importance of effective counsel throughout the process.

Popp will share his insights on what factors can create a different outcome during the fallout from an accident. The helicopter industry is a target for, and sometimes victim of, litigation and huge verdicts, so an understanding of what counts from a legal perspective in a crisis is critical.
