

Special Instrument Procedures and Increased Risk Management

Safety management systems are shaping how operators manage their risk. In bad weather, having a network of instrument procedures at private facilities or other locations can increase safety as well as the completion factor for a helicopter air ambulance or other operator. This session will review a case study to demonstrate how having a network of special instrument procedures and airways can prevent accidents and improve completion rates in marginal weather. It will also provide a brief overview of specials, from request to operations.
