

Air Medical Mechanics Basics

This 60-minute course provides a high-impact overview of key regulatory, operational, and professional principles essential to Air Medical Maintenance Technicians. Designed around AMMO's core values, the training emphasizes FAA compliance, safety-critical systems, and aircraft stewardship. Attendees will review critical regulatory resources such as 14 CFR, FAA Orders, Advisory Circulars, and InFOs, and learn to apply them in areas like documentation, fatigue management, and tool control. The class also addresses specialized subjects including NVG compliance, EFB ambiguity, fire extinguisher eligibility, oxygen system handling, and engine wash procedures. Interactive discussion and real-world examples will connect regulatory theory with practical field execution. Participants will also explore the impact of high turnover and the long-term value of professional stewardship in HAA operations.
