

# Evaluating Alterations: Aircraft Electronics Association Seminar

Many "field approvals" are requested because the installer is unsure which alterations are major and which are minor. Valuable repair station resources are wasted on just-in-case field approvals and improper documentation practices. This seminar focuses on the tools necessary to evaluate an alteration for determining its effect on the aircraft.
