

Mid-Air Collision Avoidance and Military Special Use Airspace

North Carolina has numerous military flight operation training areas that include low altitude helicopters, high speed fighter jets, airborne troop deployments, night operations, practice bomb runs, and more. In addition, the Moore County airport is sandwiched between a Military Alert Area, an MOA, and a Restricted Area. Know where these operations are located, how to determine when they are operational, how to avoid a "Pilot Deviation" from FAA/ATC, and how to avoid a mid-air collision.
