Stacking the Deck in Your Favor - Managing Risk

Seminar Details: 11:30 AM Classroom C - Playing Poker With Multiple Risks, presented by Jay Nabors, Wings of Carolina Flight Safety Officer and Professional CFI. We can't avoid the many risks we take when we fly, but we can properly manage them and "stack the deck" in our favor. There is always the possibility of unforecasted weather and in-flight equipment failure. The only way to avoid the risks associated with every flight you make is not to fly. In this seminar Jay will lead you through a discussion of how to manage multiple risk factors by examining several flight scenarios. He will point out how one risk factor by itself may not present any serious danger, but when added with other risks may cause you not to fly.
