Do Not Be a Thick Dense Pilot in Thin Dense Air--Mountain Flying

Seminar Details: 10:40 Classroom B - Don't Be a Thick Dense Pilot in Thin Dense Air, presented by Mark Kolber, Colorado Mountain CFI and Aviation Attorney. Many mountain airports in western North Carolina can be challenging for most aircraft on a warm summer day with density altitudes approaching 6000 feet in some cases, such as Mountain Air, Boone, and Ashe County to name a few. Mark will help you prepare for a trip to the mountains and how to calculate your aircraft performance. You may learn that 4 people in a Skylane departing from Boone on a hot summer day may not have enough runway for a safe departure.
