## What Would You Do? Making Good Decisions

Making sound decisions under pressure isn't easy. When one thing goes wrong on the flight deck we can usually cope with it, but when additional hazardous things need our immediate attention, it's quite a different situation. Take exit 356 from US-70 BYP 6 min (5.8 mi)
Keep left to continue on US-70 BYP E 5.6 mi
Take exit 356 for US 117 toward Goldsboro 0.3 mi
Continue on US-117/US-117 ALT N. Drive to Aviation Dr 5 min (2.9 mi)
Turn right onto US-117/US-117 ALT N 1.8 mi
Slight right onto Airport Rd NE 0.7 mi
