Take the exit toward Southport/Oak Island; Merge onto NC-133 S/River Rd SE;
Use the left 2 lanes to turn left onto NC-133/NC-87 S; Turn right onto NC-133 S/Long Beach Rd SE
Turn right at Vanessa Dr SE
