What is an Approval for Return to Service?

Every Aircraft must be Approved for Return to Service after any maintenance is performed. Even Preventive Maintenance performed by the Owner/Operator. Is it when you walk by the pilot and give them a thumbs up? Is it when a mechanic says, "Don't worry it is all documented on the work order"? It comes down to paper work. Come and find out exactly what is required and what that means.

From US-52 North / NC-8 take exit 111A towards 28th street. Use the left 2 lanes to turn left onto Indiana Ave. 1/4 mile turn right onto N Liberty St. In 1/2 mile turn right onto Fairchild Rd.
