Winter Weather Hazards!

Winter flying in most parts of the United States can adversely affect flight operations. Poor weather conditions with fast moving fronts, strong and gusty winds, blowing and drifting snow, and icing conditions are just part of the conditions that require careful planning in order to minimize their effects. Operation in this environment requires special winter operating precautions. Don't get caught in the cold, attend this important briefing and refresh your winter flying skills!
