Directions: From South: 95 North to 146 North. Take Breakneck Hill Road Exit (North Central Airport Exit) proceed straight for approximately 3 miles. Breakneck Hill Road becomes Jenks Hill Road when crossing through light. When road makes hard right - go straight and turn left into lower entrance of airport. 2nd building on the right. From North: 295 South to 146 South, take 116 South. Turn left at third light. At top of the hill DO NOT take a hard left - but go straight into airport property. Seminar at 2nd Hangar building on right.
