

Do You Plan To Have An Accident Today?

A high number of accidents on the NTSB daily report show accidents involving take off, landing and maneuvers around the airport. Ken will explore the issues that confront pilots when they begin to taxi, maneuver, take off and land on the surface of the airport. We will examine the knowledge and skills that pilots must have to operate safely in an airport environment. The causes of these accidents and incidents will be explored to provide migrations to prevent them.
