# To Fly or Not to Fly?

Recent investigations of fatal general aviation accidents reveal post mortem toxicology reports on the deceased pilots indicated the presence of illicit, prescription, or over the counter medications in 80% of subjects tested. While NTSB and FAA have not cited drug use as a causal factor in these accidents, the question of drug use and what effect this may have on pilot capability to conduct safe flight operations remains. Dr. Thomas Gross, AME, will present this portion of the program. An update on the KLWM Runway Safety Area reconstruction project will be presented by Mike Miller, KLWM Airport Manager.
