Directions: The meeting will be held in L201 and 202. They are located in the Veterans Memorial Library on the second floor. See attached maps for campus directions.

VISITING DANIEL WEBSTER COLLEGE BY CAR

Boston and the South Shore Take Interstate 93 north to Route 128. Take Route 128 south to Route 3 north. Once in New Hampshire look for exit 6. (see below.)

West of Boston Take the Massachusetts Turnpike (I-90) east to Interstate 495. Take Interstate 495 north to Route 3 north. Once in New Hampshire look for Exit 6. (See below.)

Southern Connecticut and New York Take Interstate 95 north to Interstate 91 north to Interstate 84 east to Massachusetts Turnpike (I-90 east), then follow to Interstate 290 east. Turn north on Interstate 495 and north again on Route 3. Once in New Hampshire look for Exit 6. (See below.)

North of Daniel Webster Take Interstate 93 south to 293 to the Everett Turnpike south to Exit 6. Turn LEFT and proceed through TWO stoplights. Turn LEFT onto Blue Hill Avenue and continue 1.1 miles to the entrance of University Drive. Turn right.

Exit 6 From Route 3 (Everett Turnpike), Take Exit 6. Go east approximately 1/8 mile. Turn left onto Blue Hill Avenue and continue 1.1 miles to the entrance of University Drive. Turn right.
