Loss of Control, especially as a result of continued VFR Flight into IMC Conditions can be very deadly. Learn more as to why it can happen, even to well qualified pilots. Also learn strategies to avoid becoming part of the statistics and keep you stress levels low regarding understanding the practical side of poor VFR flight conditions.
