Flight Instructor Refresher Course (FIRC)

The Soaring Safety Foundation Flight Instructor Refresher Course (FIRC) is an FAA Approved 2-day interactive course meeting the FAA requirement for the renewal of any unexpired Flight Instructor Certificate. This course is tailored to the needs of glider pilots and instructors but is educational and beneficial for any pilot. You don't need to be a Flight Instructor or even hold a glider rating to sign up and enjoy the benefits. A terrific benefit for airplane instructors that tow gliders, or may have an interest in towing gliders. Also a great start ground refresher for those that may have an expired Flight Instructor Certificate, but need to refresh in preparation for a future Flight Instructor reinstatement practical test.

Directions: From Exit #32 on Route 2, proceed towards Main Street heading North.

About 0.4 Miles north of Route 2, take a left on to Hamilton Street.

After 0.3 Miles turn right on to Crawford Street

Proceed approximately 1.1 Miles to 567 Crawford Street and Airport Blvd and the Terminal Building.
