

The Space Shuttle Columbia Crew Survival Investigation

This presentation is a National offering that examines what happened to the crew and the crew module of *Columbia* during entry. It does not address the cause of the accident. That was more than adequately addressed by the *Columbia* Accident Investigation Board, formed on the day of the accident as a Presidential Commission. It will examine the five events that occurred post de-orbit burn that had lethal potential. By evaluating each event in turn, a picture of crew survivability for future accidents can be painted. Of course, the *Columbia* crew experienced all five events from which there was no hope of survival. We learn how to correlate these events into our own general aviation safety mindset.
