Simsbury Airport Supports General Aviation

As you look out over the scene at the Simsbury Fly-In, you are seeing a good representation of what's known as "General Aviation". You have probably heard that term before, but if you are like most people, may not know exactly what it means. So let's begin with a simple definition: General Aviation (GA) is everything in aviation *except* the airlines.

Aviation begins – literally – with flight training. Aviation, including the airlines, simply could not exist if it were not for the training provided at GA airports like ours. Flight schools generate new pilots, some of whom then obtain advanced pilot ratings and move on to fly for the airlines. Others find jobs in the aviation business, filling roles as pilots, mechanics, or administrators. Still others use flying for recreation. A vital part of Simsbury Airport's services is Future Flyers of Connecticut, our own flight school.

GA Airplanes Used Widely for Business Purposes

Many GA pilots use their aircraft, or rent aircraft, for business purposes. The airlines serve only the 600 or so larger airports in this country. This is a fraction of the 5,200 airports that business people can use to reach those other locations with ease and

convenience not available via the airlines. Of course, GA pilots also use the larger airports, too, to avoid the hassle and delays that can occur with airline travel. At Simsbury Airport, we have a number of pilots who use their airplanes as a vital part of their business operation.

Business aviation is a major economic contributor wherever it flies. On virtually every day, charter and corporate airplanes and helicopters arrive at Simsbury Airport from other airports to carry passengers to and from this area to conduct business.

Some of the most dramatic scenes we see on TV involve the use of GA aircraft in emergencies. We continued on page 15

Town of Simsbury Considering Acquisition of Airport

or several years, the Town of Simsbury has been carefully considering whether to acquire Simsbury Airport. An aviation consultant was hired, using Federal and State funding, to conduct an initial study. At present, the Simsbury Economic Development Commission is reviewing the matter.

We strongly support acquisition by the Town. Here are some of the reasons.

On average, two airports close each month. Once closed, they never return. All of us feel the impact, because the result is that more and more airplanes are crowded into fewer and fewer airports. Air traffic delays are already a problem, and airport congestion makes the problem worse. Airports are a major contributor to economic development in their communities. But this is true only for airports whose future is assured. Airports like ours that are privately owned are subject to closure.

Businesses shy away from investing at airports whose future is in doubt. Town ownership assures the airport's future, and opens the door to economic development.



have all seen the firefighting airplanes and helicopters dropping fire retardant on forest fires – a risky business, but extremely valuable when other methods can't be used. During floods, helicopters are used to lift people from housetops, saving many lives as they did in New Orleans during Hurricane Katrina. Most of us are aware of the valuable medevac services provided locally by Hartford Hospital's Life Star helicopter, and by similar life-saving operations at cities

Joe Bellino Is Long-Time Fly-In Chairman

Today you are likely to see a very busy guy driving around the airport in a golf cart with "Air Boss" on his shirt, making sure our event goes smoothly. That would be Joe Bellino, who has chaired the Fly-In for the past eleven years. He jokes that he was appointed to the Chairmanship because he was late for a meeting.

In his first year, he recalls that the Fly-In attracted perhaps 30 airplanes and about 50 spectators. Under Joe's leadership, the Fly-In is one of the largest aviation events in New



England. Joe is a long-time member of the Simsbury Volunteer Ambulance Association, and that group often practiced extrications from wrecked autos. Joe felt that it would be useful for our spectators to see that activity, so it has become a standard feature of our show. 


Federal & State Governments Would Fund 98.75%

Both the Federal and State government want to keep our airport open. Public funding for airport acquisition covers all but 1.25% of the purchase costs. Our airport, along with its open space and wetlands, can be acquired for very low cost to the Town. A nearby example is Plainville, which is acquiring

Robertson Airport with \$7.4 Million in FAA and State funding.

What about ongoing operating costs for the Town? If the Town were to operate the airport in the same way as many other municipal airports, the ongoing budget impact should be zero. How is this achievable? By leasing the airport operation to a professional "Fixed-Base Operator (FBO) that would run the airport and pay virtually all expenses. The lease fee would be set at a level that covers all of the few costs incurred directly by the Town (for example, legal costs). As a result, the Town's costs would be covered, it would require no staff additions, and would not be directly involved in airport operations. Overall airport governance would be achieved via an Airport Commission, staffed by volunteers, along the lines of other Town Commissions such as Planning. This method is in successful use at smaller airports around the country.

The benefits? Retention of a unique Town asset. Economic development potential. Transportation. Recreation. Open space preservation.






Some years ago, Simsbury Airport was the base for an agricultural spraying business. In its waning years here, spraying was done mostly to control insects.


