There is always a concern for safety and we should all consider carrying safety equipment in the plane at all times. If we planned to go down, we wouldn't fly! However, with proper planning, an emergency can be more comfortable, and we can increase our chances of being rescued quickly. If you think safety, you will fly safer knowing you are prepared.
