

## ADS-B: The 2020 Mandate

Aircraft must have Automatic Dependent Surveillance Broadcast (ADS-B) capability in certain U.S. airspace after December 2019. This seminar will discuss how ADS-B works, who needs to equip, and what equipment options are available based on the current state-of-the-art.

**Directions:** From I-93 Exit 14, proceed east on NH Route 9 (Loudon Road) approximately 1 mile to the traffic light at the intersection with Airport Road. Turn right and proceed south on Airport Road approximately 1/2 mile to Concord Municipal Airport.
