

Can Your Airplane Really Perform?

If the field is short, do you know your airplane well enough to guarantee you can land and depart safely? Join with pilots from the Northeast Comanche Tribe to calculate takeoff and landing distances required for your airplane, then compare your calculated values to actual measured distances on the runway. The results may be surprising! Rain date, Sunday, June 20, 2021.

Directions: From downtown Newport, proceed north on NH Route 10. The entrance to Parlin Field is on the west side of Route 10, about 2 miles north of town. From points north, take I-89 to Exit 13 (Grantham) and proceed south on NH Route 10. Parlin Field is about 9 miles south of Exit 13.
