

## Tour of Atlanta Air Route Traffic Control Center

Do not miss this exciting adventure not normally seen by most pilots. This is a tour of the Atlanta (ZTL) Air Route Traffic Control Center (ARTCC). You will receive an initial briefing in a class room by ARTCC personnel, after which you will visit a training room, then observe the active controllers in the radar operations room. See how air traffic is handled and moved in high density areas. Preregistration is required. Please click the link below and register TODAY.

**Directions:** Weather permitting, you will fly from North Carolina in your aircraft to Hampton, GA (4A7), where transportation will be provided to the center by the ATL center operations. Be prepared (consider heavy traffic ) to arrive at the Hampton airport by 11:30 to 12:00 noon if you are bringing your brown bag lunch to eat with others attending.

Note: 4A7 is south of Atlanta, 150 nm from Hendersonville-Asheville, and 115 nm from 1A5 and RHP.
