

A Managed Risk Approach to Collision Avoidance

"LOOK OUT!" The more flying hours you accumulate, the more likely you are to be able to relate to at least one incident of a near miss incident or a need to execute an aggressive escape maneuver to avoid another aircraft. The "normalcy bias" is your enemy when it comes to taking immediate action to avoid a collision. Bob McCabe is a seasoned pilot and CFI with more than 20 years of flying and teaching experience. Learn from someone who has "been there" and let's work to improve your situational awareness and reduce your reaction time in the critical moments of "loss of separation" scenarios.
