On the first event you link to, please log in (left hand top corner). By logging in you assure that the system accesses your correct information. As you register for additional seminars via links from this document, check that the system has your name pre-loaded in the registration information. When you finish registering for an individual seminar, click "BACK" on you web-browser to return to this document.

This method of quickly allowing you to register for multiple seminars is an experiment, please let me know at the program if you think it is helpful.

If you preregister for the individual seminars, then just check your name on the sign in sheet at the event in order to receive credit. If you don't pre-register, you may still receive credit by providing your name and the email address that you use on faasafety.gov, on the sign-in sheet at the event.
