

## Elementary Aerodynamics for Pilots

This seminar will present a mildly mathematical exploration of the lift and drag for low-speed flight, leading to an examination of the aircraft envelope, as represented by the V-n diagram. High mathematical skills are not necessary for good takeaways from this event.
