

Verne Jobst soloed at age 16 and flew all kinds of aircraft including balloons and gliders, B-17's (EAA's Aluminum Overcast) to 747 transports. In 1951 he flew DC-3s for Capital Airlines and with United Airlines as well as a corporate pilot for U.S. Steel, C&O Railroad and Blannox. In addition to his personal flying he also was president of the International Aerobatic Club (IAC) from 1973 to 1978. He was inducted into the Flight Instructors Hall of Fame in 1999 and was Chief Pilot for the 1977 Lindbergh Commemorative Tour which he flew all across the country behind the controls of the EAA Air Museum's Spirit of St. Louis replica. Among his 40,000 logged flight hours, more than 11,500 were giving instruction to fledgling pilots.
