We will be continuing our Aviation Safety Programs by hosting the next FAA Safety event in June. Topic of this discussion will be the hazards of flying at night. Things that will be discussed will include: Vision in Flight, Visual Illusions, Disorientation, Flight Planning, Emergencies, CFIT, and Currency Regulations.

We will be starting at 6:30 P.M. and the event will be in the main Illinois Aviation Academy hangar. From 6:30 P.M. to 7:00 P.M. we will be serving hot dogs and drinks. From 7:00 P.M. to 8:00 P.M. we will have our main event discussion. After 8:00 we will be preflighting aircraft and taking people up for the Night Challenge. Option1 - Easy - Flight will be estimated 30 minutes, and involve a simulated electrical failure.

Option 2- Medium - Flight will be estimated 40 minutes and involve diversion do to weather, simulated electrical failure, blacked out landing.

Option 3 - Difficult - Flight will be estimated 45 minutes and involve simulated flight into instrument / icing conditions at night, diversion, failing electrical system.
