# High Altitude Reduce Oxygen Enclosure Training

High Altitude training in reduced oxygen enclosure provided by Civil Aerospace Medical Institute (CAMI). Sessions provided from 0900-1700 on both 10/1 and 10/2, credit towards High Altitude endorsement, certificate provided. In addition, there is optional classroom training offered from 0900 to 1030 each day. To participate in the enclosure training, the participant must be at least 18 years old and have a current 3rd Class Medical. There is no charge. The enclosure accommodates up to 5 people at a time and each session is 20 min plus a pre-briefing.
