Safety Meeting at PWK - Get your HEMS Tool Up

What makes the HEMS tool such a valuable supplement to a weather briefing is that it fills a niche in the lineup of aviation weather information sources. The tool isn't a surface observation report (like a METAR) or a terminal forecast but is a resource that helps you figure out what the weather may be in the low levels and at the surface between two reporting points.

Using the HEMS tool during your flight planning will make you a safer, more weather-savvy pilot, because the tool was designed to increase pilots' situational awareness down low, thus reducing loss-of-control accidents (LOC) and controlled flight into terrain (CFIT).
