Don't get behind the plane! During the critical phases of flight, you don't have the luxury of doing one thing at a time. But you can reduce the jam and stress by completing tasks as early as possible when things are happening all at once in the last few minutes of the approach and landing. And, by seeing the big picture in the sky, you'll be able to anticipate what's going to happen when and with who.

Speaker Bio:

Marc Epner is a Chicago-based pilot, who started his love affair with aviation when he was a young boy growing up in the southern suburbs of Chicago. After earning his private pilot license in 1976, Marc lost his medical in 1979 and didn't set foot in a general aviation airplane until 2004, a full 25 years later.
