## **Event Details**

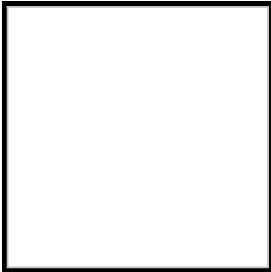
