

Hindsight Bias and CFIT

Human biases are patterns of reasoning that weigh the value of information according to pre-conceived beliefs. Biases can influence a person to be in favor or against an idea, a person or even groups of people, compared to something else.

These same patterns of reasoning can also influence decision-making for pilots when facing a controlled flight into terrain (CFIT) situation. This seminar explores the influence of human biases on decision-making in a CFIT situation and how these same biases can affect an incident investigation after such an event.

This is a one-hour seminar.
