

Airspace, Weather, and Internet Resources

Sporty's instructional team will help demystify the complex types of airspace in use today. Topics will include "alphabet" airspace as well as Special Use Airspace, TFRs, national security areas, military intercept procedures and the Washington SFRA.

Weather and internet resource topics will include interpreting aviation weather reports and extracting additional clues they provide about atmospheric conditions. Also included will be a host of invaluable internet weather resources and in-flight weather products including ADS-B.
