

ADS-B AVIONICS - Enhancing Airspace Safety and Information

The FAA mandates that all aircraft utilizing any form of controlled airspace shall be required to have ADS-B avionics installed and operational on their aircraft by 2020. Come learn how this system enhances flying safety by helping to provide in-flight collision avoidance information as well as real time in cockpit weather and flight planning information.

The technical and operational overview of the impending ADS-B equipage requirements as mandated by the FAA for implementation by 2020 will be discussed.

Directions: Fly-ins should ask ground control for taxi instructions to Spirit Avionics. Drive-ins enter the main building at the designated entrance.
