

ATTENTION PILOTS / Hypoxia Recognition / 3 Day Event

This event will allow any pilot with a minimum of a 3rd Class Medical Certificate and 18 years of age the opportunity to participate in the hypoxia recognition training. In addition to the portable hypoxia chamber, there will be a spatial disorientation simulator available for pilots participation.
