

Topic of the Month / Best Glide Speed and Distance

Discuss the scope and safety benefits of flying the airplane at best glide speed while maneuvering to a forced landing runway or off airport landing area. Acquaint pilots with available resources. Encourage pilots to maintain proficiency through frequent forced landing practice. Encourage pilots to participate in the WINGS Pilot Proficiency Program
