**Monthly Meeting of the Columbus Chapter EAA/IMC Club
(Mastering the Art of Instrument Navigation)**

At towered airports, ATC plays a vital and important role in ensuring safety, guiding the movement of airplanes, and coordinating services with approach and departure control.

Deral Carson, tower manager at KOSU, will present his perspective on ATC's role in enhancing safety for IFR/VFR pilots at a towered field, especially KOSU. Additionally, he will outline services that his tower staff can provide to IFR/VFR pilots, and how "handoffs" to Columbus Departure and/or Columbus Approach are handled. Emphasis will be placed on how pilots and controllers can work together to make the system more efficient, less stressful, and more enjoyable. Also, Deral will address the potential impact of upcoming construction changes to the airport. Finally, he will speak to the issue of unmanned aircraft systems (U.A.S.)--aka drones--flying in the surrounding airspace.
