Maintenance and Certification Placards

Teaching Points:

Discuss the scope and safety benefits of lock out/tag out procedures and Maintenance Placards.

Certification Placards, what are they?

Acquaint pilots with available resources.

Encourage pilots to adopt more robust airworthiness status processes.

The GAJSC has identified a number of fatal general aviation accidents that were caused by attempting flight in aircraft that were undergoing maintenance and not yet returned to service.

This safety enhancement suggests adopting lock out/tag out methodology to ensure pilots are aware of un-airworthy aircraft conditions.

NOTE: A brief presentation will be given after the placard discussion titled: MiraCheck CoPilot is the future of aviation safety.
