

Short Field Operations - July Topic of the Month

Mismanagement of short field operations is cited in NTSB accident reports that involve pilots with and without short field experience. The General Aviation Joint Safety Committee (GAJSC) feel that additional training in short field operations may reduce loss of control and controlled flight into terrain accidents.

Teaching Points:

- Discuss the necessity of planning and practice in short field operations.
- Training and practice with a CFI is the best way to prepare for short field operations.
- Predicting aircraft and pilot performance is essential to short field operations safety.
