This presentation discusses the safety risk elements of owner/operator maintenance, managing distractions, multi-engine emergency procedures and training, and the startle response to emergencies. Factors that contribute to Loss of Control accidents include; pilot proficiency, Aeronautical Decision Making (ADM), inadequate hazard identification and risk assessment, hazardous operational environments, and human factors.
