

## Gaming the System

A study of General Aviation controlled flight into terrain (CFIT) accidents found that a significant number of pilot fatality post-mortem examinations detected the presence of pre-existing medical conditions and/or prescription and over-the-counter medication use. A smaller number of cases revealed recreational drug use.

This seminar emphasizes the importance of disclosing a complete medical history, conditions and medication inventory to your medical examiner during the certification process, as well as performing a basic self-assessment before each flight.

The seminar will be held on the second floor of the terminal building. If driving in, park on the south side of the building. If flying in, park on the north side on the ramp.
