Stalls and spins are often feared. Sometimes they are deadly. These both can be demystified and even embraced. Concepts like turning tendencies, stall recovery procedures, spin phases/principle/recovery techniques and more are discussed. With a heavy emphasis on angle of attack (AOA), pilots will have a clear understanding how AOA plays into stall and spins. Taught by veteran CFI Robert Haynes who is passionate about teaching spins and has done over 3500 spins and certified hundreds of CFI candidates. In fact, Robert recently set the world record for most number of individual spins in one flight. He did 100 individual spins (not just turns). Come and enjoy SPART. You won't be disappointed.
