Why engines fail is easy to understand. Helping pilots understand how to bring a powerless airplane down safely is more difficult. This thought-provoking presentation touches on a number of seldom-discussed factors related to successfully handling an engine failure, including: engine failure causes, pre-flight planning, managing stress in emergencies, airspeed control, impact management, and crash survivability.
