

# Taildragger Aviating Techniques - 6th Annual

This “conventional gear” flying course taught by tail wheel flight instructor John Chmiel reviews these subjects: tail wheel endorsement criteria, FAR's, tail wheel vs. tricycle differences, transition maneuvers, taxi/take-off techniques, 3-pt landings, & wheel landings. 2012 program contains new video, techniques, with display aircraft.
