

# How To Win A Spot Landing Contest or 'Learn To Land Where You Want To!'

Most pilots use "smooth" as the primary criteria for judging their landings. "Smooth" is not a term used to describe a proper landing in any FAA PTS. This clinic will discuss in detail how to land where you want to and the proper techniques to use when considering: traffic pattern shape, glide path, approach speed, aiming points, decision points, etc.
