Instrument Knowledge Summary and Review

This eight hour seminar is intended to serve as a review, introduction or capstone to study for the instrument knowledge examination. It is not intended as a stand alone preparation for the examination. Those already possessing an instrument ticket will find this useful as a refresher.

We will use the the ASA Instrument Rating Test Prep as our text. While the primary text is the 2015 edition the 2014 will be acceptable.

Attendees are expected to provide their own text but may, at their own discretion, attend with no text. A limited number of texts will be available at the Morey Airplane Co. All subject matter included on the instrument exam are included. Each subject is briefly discussed and typical exam questions are analyzed.

Log book entries crediting attendees with the number of hours in attendance will be provided by certificated flight instructor leading the course.

Course begins at 8:00 AM and dismisses at 5:00 PM.
