

## IMC Club Chapter Meeting: Dangerous Fog and ADM Issues

An IMC club scenario is presented involving IFR flight from South Bend, Indiana to Springfield, Ohio in a Beech Model 18 twin. Enroute weather changes abruptly requiring a divert to Dayton. Weather minimums for the ILS are challenging. Detailed discussion on safety of flight ADM, weather phenomena causing fog and rapid decline in weather conditions is planned. Redbird SIM opportunities to fly this challenging approach are available. Light snacks are made available on site.
